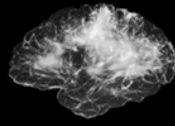

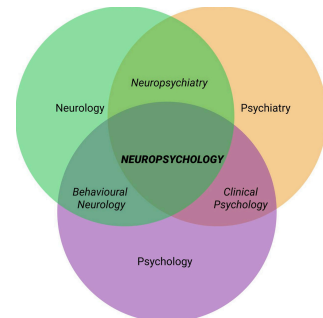

Introduction to Neuropsychology

Welcome to Dr Katie Hamilton Inc's neuropsychology practice. Please read this information carefully to understand the services provided in this practice by myself, Katie Hamilton, and my colleague, Timothy Bean.

What is Neuropsychology?

Neuropsychology is the study of the human mind. We study how disease and trauma affect the brain, and the relationships between the brain and cognition, behaviour, personality, and mood. Our goal is to help you and your support structures understand your brain trauma, and to help you reclaim your life.



When to see a Neuropsychologist

People consult a neuropsychologist after brain injury or neurological illness, or when they notice changes in thinking, behaviour, or mood. Common causes include head injury (falls, accidents), stroke, brain tumours, and dementia (such as Alzheimer's or Parkinson's disease). Neuropsychological intervention may also benefit those with complications in brain functioning following infections such as meningitis or encephalitis, or those with chronic conditions such as HIV or diabetes

The Diagnostic & Treatment Process

Treatment focuses on understanding how your brain functioning has changed through discussion, history-taking, and neurocognitive assessment. We identify how these changes affect your thinking, mood, behaviour, and personality. Rehabilitation includes restoring function where possible and developing practical strategies to manage daily challenges. Sessions are individual, but you are welcome to bring someone for support or to assist with information and feedback.

Our Services

Initial Appointment



First appointments are 50 minutes and will focus on understanding what has happened and why you have sought treatment. This will aid in deciding whether you need a formal neurocognitive assessment or can immediately start rehabilitation and/or psychotherapy. Cost is R1400, charged on the day of the appointment.

Neurocognitive Assessment



Neurocognitive assessment involves a series of tasks tailored to your situation. We will ask you questions and see how you respond, and we will do some pen-and-paper activities. Each task is designed to see how your brain responds to different tasks, and how different brain processes are interacting. Standard medical aid rates apply.

Neurorehabilitation & Psychotherapy



These are individual sessions, either in person or online, tailored to your needs. We work together through discussion and practical exercises to understand how your thinking, mood, and daily functioning may have been affected. These sessions focus on building strategies to manage challenges, improve functioning, and support your emotional wellbeing and adjustment over time. Standard medical aid rates apply.
